HELP	POSITION	DESCRIPTION
TEAM	Manager	Administrates team, organizes team support, conducts practices, follows official rules and regulations, and attends league meetings.
	Coach	Assists manager, participates in practices, and helps apply rules and regulations.
	Team Parent	Schedules the team's assignments to operate the scoreboard and announce games. Organizes team baskets for silent auction for the annual golf outing fundraiser. * Collects/submits the team's raffle ticket stubs.
	Field Maintenance	Groom, rake, line, and prepare field for play before and after games.
	Spring Clean-up	Participate in the annual field clean-up days at one of the seven fields our league maintains. Parents, and sometimes players, work alongside their team's manager and coaches to make the fields playable for the upcoming season.
LEAGUE	League Officer	The Board of Directors consists of a number of elected and appointed positions. Elections and appointments are conducted at the annual election meeting in the Fall.
	Booster Members	Members coordinate the primary booster activities that annually support our players and league. Activities for which members are needed include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Merchandising: manages the creation and sale of sports apparel and other items. ▪ Fundraising: participate in managing the silent auction. ▪ Team Basket Coordinators: collects team baskets for silent auction. ▪ Snack Stand Coordinators: schedule staff for snack stand at Lippold and Main Beach. ▪ Snack Stand Supply: manage and purchase snack stand inventory during season. ▪ Snack Stand Stocker: stock snack stands once a week. ▪ Team Parent Liaison: communicate to all team parents about upcoming league events ▪ Team Pictures: coordinate team photo night at Indian Prairie Elementary School. ▪
UMPIRE	Division umpire	An "un-patched" umpire is assigned to umpire games in a division based on experience, knowledge of the rules, and availability.
	Patch umpire	"Patched" (certified by an umpire association) and experienced umpires may apply to umpire games in the Major East and Minor divisions.
	Trainee	Inexperienced umpires are provided training and must pass a test in order to umpire games in the younger divisions.

* All parents of children with games scheduled at Lundahl Middle School, Main Beach, and Lippold Park will be scheduled by their Manager or Team Parent to staff the scoreboards and announcer stations. Children under 16 years of age are NOT allowed in the scoreboard/announcer area (upstairs) at Lundahl Middle School or Main Beach. Snack stands at Lippold Park and Main Beach will be staffed by paid employees of the league. **Each family will be charged a \$25 fee per child (excluding rookie players with a maximum of \$50 per family) payable at registration, to cover the cost of operating the snack stands.**
